### NATIONAL STANDARDS

Our end of year assessments show that overall our students are achieving very well in the Reading, Writing and Mathematics national standards.

**READING**—92% of our Year 1 to 8 students are at or above the national standard expectation.

**WRITING**—87% of our Year 1 to 8 students are at or above the national standard expectation.

**MATHEMATICS**—91% of our year 1 to 8 students are at or above national standard expectation.

Students not achieving the standard have received extra assistance from programmes such as 'Early Words' and 'Spring into Maths'. Students exceeding the standard, 33% of students exceeded in reading, 20% in Writing and 28% in Mathematics.
