EMERGENCY PROCEDURES UPDATE

Our school hall is designated as a Community Emergency Hub (it used to be called a Civil Defence Centre). We have been working with the team from WREMO (Wellington Regional Emergency Management Office) to ensure we have up to date information and resources from them. Over the next while we will include more information about the Hub and how it works in the community- particularly once our hall is refurbished and back in action!

Meanwhile we are always reviewing our current school emergency procedures and ensuring our own systems for responding to an emergency are the best they can be, and we are spending some time updating our supplies. This is always work in progress and we will update you as things continue to progress. A big thank you to our parents who helped clean out the shed space for us- what a transformation!

STUDENT EMERGENCY KITS

Over the holidays we are hoping you might be able to find some time to create an Emergency Kit for each of your children. We've attached a separate notice about this, but essentially the kit is an ice-cream container (or similar) with a few snacks and supplies to help your child in case they need to remain at school for a wee while. We do have supplies of water, first aid kits and other survival equipment kept at school- but this is just an individual 'care pack' to keep spirits up and to tide children over with a bit of extra sustenance until they can be collected.

CONTACT DETAILS FORM

In the event of an emergency where school is closed, you will be contacted through our text alert and/or email systems. Children will be signed out by the teacher. We expect that in most cases we will be signing them out to you as their parent/caregiver, but in the event that you are held up we would like to know a few names of people that have delegation to collect your child. You might like to think of people that live close by and/or would have easiest access to the school and are familiar to your child.
