*Thursday 2nd June 6.30pm*

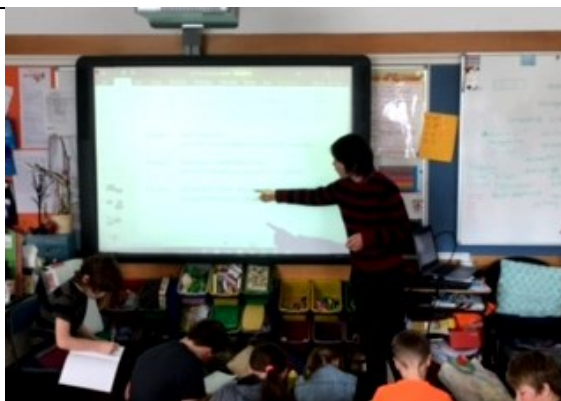
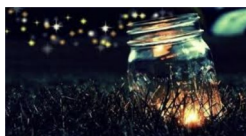
## TRAFFIC WARNING
