Thank you for the speedy response to sign your children up for our Roseneath netball and basketball teams this season.

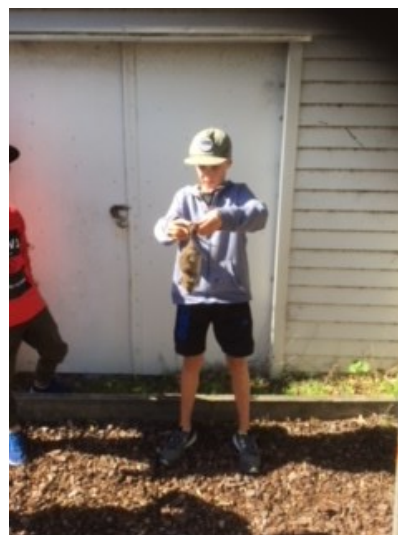

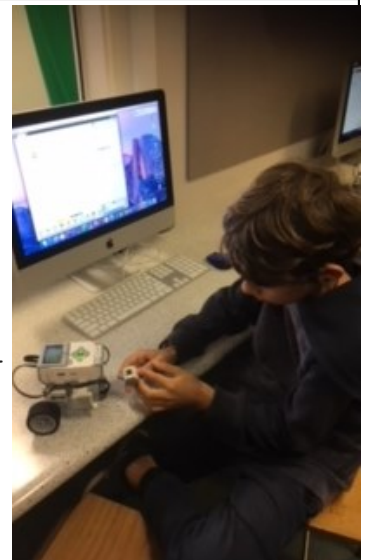

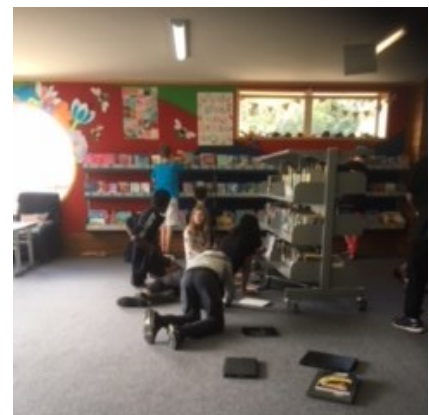
