PRINCIPAL AND TEACHERS TO STRIKE FRIDAY 16TH NOVEMBER

School will be closed for the day. The New Zealand Educational Institute (NZEI) Te Riu Roa has advised the Board of Trustees that the Principal and Teachers at our school will strike for the day on Friday, 16 November 2018.

The Board has carefully considered the availability of teaching staff and, unfortunately, decided that we are unable to provide either normal teaching services or limited supervision during the strike. The school will need to close during this strike.

It is important that you make alternative arrangements for the care of your child/children on the day of the strike. If this is difficult please contact Joanne in the office so that we can help.

With the support of the Board, Roseneath After School Care (RASC) will be offering a programme for the School day. The cost of the programme is \$40/child. Please contact Pyar (027 689 8845).

We appreciate that this is inconvenient for parents, caregivers and students, but please be assured that student safety is our main concern. Thank you for your understanding. Although we are disappointed to have to close our School for another day, we are grateful to have a conscientious and talented teaching team who work hard to ensure that our children achieve their very best.

Their self awareness and honesty was amazing, and especially heading away for such a physically and emotionally challenging experience. It was lovely to see them ready to give it their best shot and to support each other.

Go well, Upper Bridge, I hope you get some wonderful weather, and I know you will love the challenge and 'enjoy the journey!' Anne, as always you have spent so many hours shopping, preparing, cooking, and planning for this camp. Thank you- we know it is a really exciting opportunity for our senior students. Our parent helpers have also been busy preparing and training for the camp. Thank you, we know it is a week away from the rest of your family, away from your work and life commitments, and appreciate the investment you are making for our children.

Parents, thank you for all your help getting gear and camp payments organised. The final costs aren't known until after the camp (once the final food bills are known and final fundraising money comes in) but it will be around the \$250 mark. Together you have raised about \$100 per camper in fundraising.
