### WELLBEING STUDENT SURVEY

Recently our Year 4 to 8 students were asked to complete an anonymous survey on how safe and positive they feel in our school environment. Overall the results were very encouraging. There are a number of findings that we will need to investigate.

The House Leaders and Class representatives have already looked at the findings and have been talking about why only 84.5% thought that 'Learning is interesting at our school'. We are also looking at ways students can come up with the solutions to some of the other areas that need investigating.

Here are the questions the students were asked and this is the percentage that thought they strongly agreed or agreed.

- I feel I am included at school - 98.3
- I feel safe at school - 96.6%
- Everyone knows the school rules about behaviour - 87.9%
- Everyone thinks our school values are important (like respect others) - 96.6%
- Behaviours like hitting or bullying are not okay at school - 100%
- At School everyone knows what to do if someone is being hurt or bullied - 87.9
- Teachers and students care about each other - 96.6%
- Teachers are interested in me and the things I do - 87.9%
- I think that our school values are important - 99.3%
- Students have a say in what happens at school - 82.7%
- Our school wants us to get on with students from different cultures and backgrounds 100%
- At school we celebrate the good things students do- 89.6%
- I always feel safe when I am going to or from school - 93.1%
- Learning is interesting at our school - 84.5%
- Teachers take action if someone is being hit or bullied - 94.9%
- Our school values the cultures of all our students - 98.2%
- My teacher understands how I learn - 84.5%
- There is an adult at school that I can talk to about problems I may have - 79.3
- Teachers think all students can do well - 94.9%
