None of this would be possible without the wonder teachers we have here at Roseneath. They truly deserve a well earned break before we embark on another action packed term.

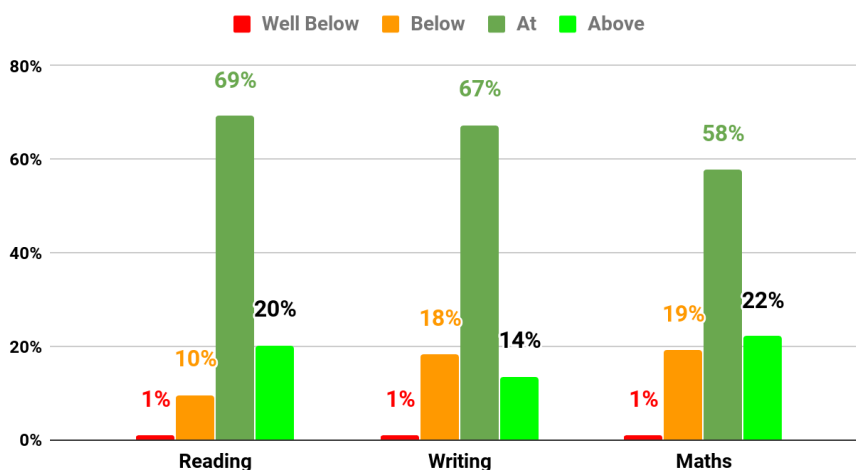

PLASTIC BAG LEVY PETITION

We have been looking at how plastic bags affect the environment. We have decided to place a petition to the government to say that we want a levy on plastic bags. We have found out that it costs the City Council a lot of money to pay for fences at the dump to keep all the plastic bags in. Plastic bags kill marine life by them eating the bags or having these bags wrapped around them. New Zealanders use 1.6 billion plastic bags a year. On average one plastic bag is used for 12 minutes before it is thrown out. It takes about 1000 years for a piece of plastic to break down properly. If you want a levy on plastic bags there will be a form at the office to fill in.
