## SCHOOL PHOTOS - THIS MONDAY

**EARLY BIRD is cheaper, especially when ordering 3 of identical photos.**

Sizes range from 10 x 6 inches to 10 x 15 inches—one order prices range from \$16 to \$45 and if ordering 3 identical photos the price ranges from \$13 to \$30.

They will be taking class, individual and sibling photos but not group ones.

To view the pictures, they offer an online ordering system. The school office will be advised of the password for the online gallery when the proofs are ready. Proofs are available to view online approximately two weeks after the date of the photo shoot, you will then have two weeks to place an order and two weeks after orders have closed packaged prints will be delivered back to the centre. Orders that remain unpaid after the two-week order period will be available at our standard pricing. You can ring them at any stage even to put in an order if you do not want to book on line.
