ERO REPORT - FINALISED

We have had our ERO report finalised and loaded onto the ERO website. We are really pleased with the report and for us it reflects a lot of the aspects we cherish here at Roseneath. I have taken a short section out of the report that I think really speaks to the heart of all we strive to do here. It is heartening to see that ERO found this too.

Children participate and learn in a caring, collaborative learning environment. They enjoy a sense of belonging and connection to the school, friends and community. They are included and cared for and well supported to establish and maintain positive, respectful relationships. Opportunities for leadership and to have their voices heard, are well established.

A broad, responsive curriculum enables children to learn, achieve and progress across a range of topics and subjects. While literacy and mathematics are prioritised, there is also a strong focus on digital technology, science, the arts, physical education and key competencies. Children are supported to take greater responsibility for their progress and achievement. Meaningful contexts support their engagement in learning.

Families are welcomed and valued as partners in their children's learning. A high level of parent participation is apparent. They are well informed about their children's progress and achievement.

PLANNING FOR 2018

"We will soon commence planning for next year's classes. Our class structure is based on Ministry funding and on the numbers of children in each year group, and as such can change from year to year. As in previous years, we will have some composite classes (that is, two or more year groups in one class).

Whilst in most situations there will only be the one classroom option for your child, we may have some with overlapping composites (e.g. Year 2/3 and Year 3/4). In this situation, teachers and the leadership team will carefully consider each child- socially, emotionally and academically- when considering their placement. If you have anything you wish us to be aware of when considering your child's class placement for 2018, we need to have that information in writing by Friday 3rd November. 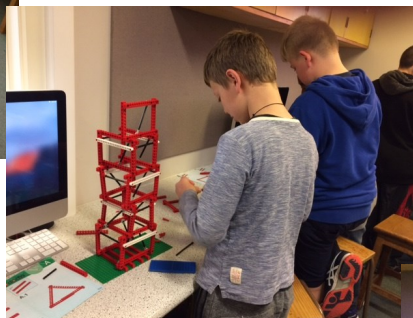
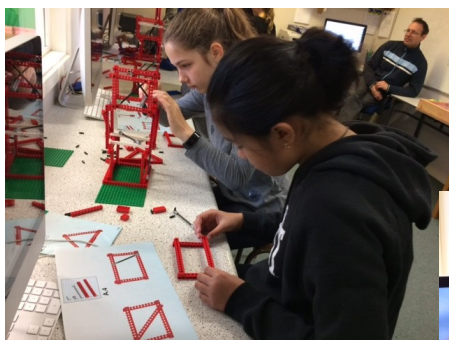
