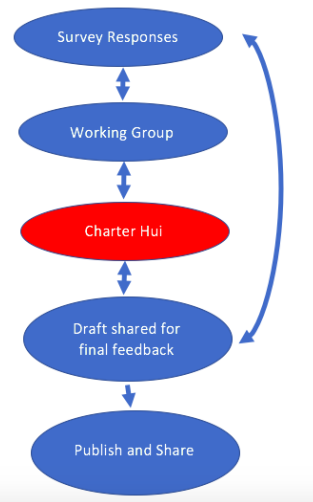
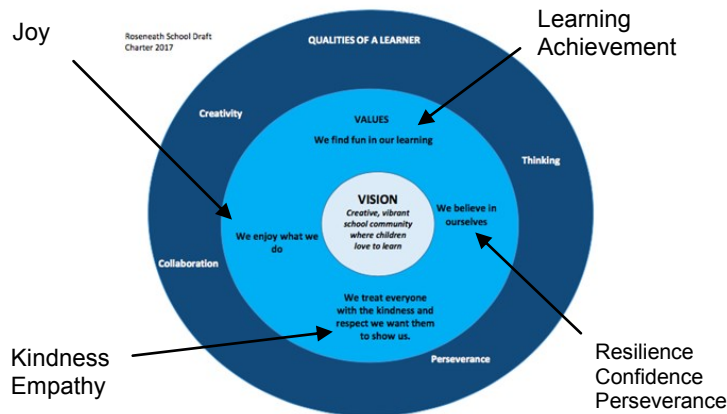
Kids' Movie Night -

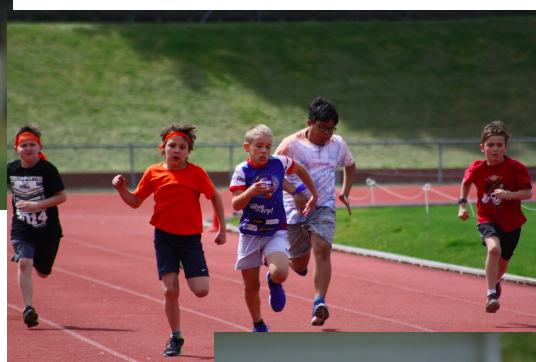
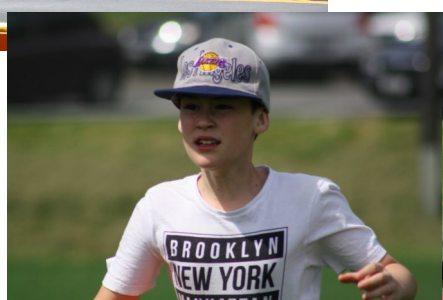
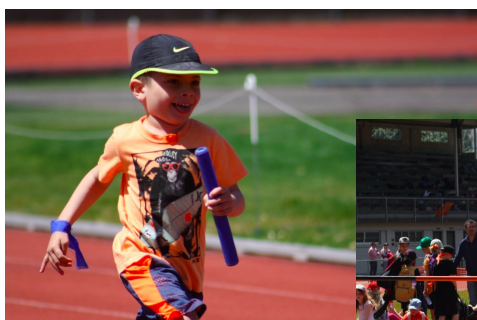
I would also like to thank all the staff and parents who helped out. It takes a lot of organising to make an event like this work successfully.

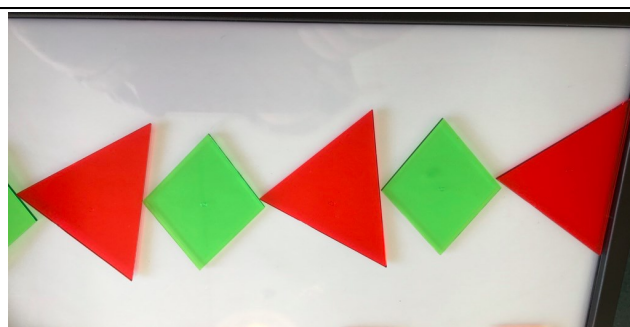

The prices are: \$16 per calendar, \$20 per diary and \$15 per pack of 8 note cards. (If you want the sketch pad or mousepad advertised on the flyer, these are also \$15 each).

The last day for orders is **Monday 30 October**. Payment at the same time you order is ideal, or otherwise anytime up to the date the order is picked up by you (expected to be at the start of December).
