### STATIONERY FOR 2018

The rules around schools selling stationery has changed so we are looking for the best way to offer you choice in purchasing your stationery for 2018. We are keen to hear what option you would prefer from us here at school.

We have a few options that could be available and they will have differing cost and accessibility.

1. Stationery from school (parents pay the school, we organise the stationery and give it to teachers. We get this at wholesale which we pass on to you).
2. Pre-packed stationery packs that you order online through one of our suppliers (set package and able to be paid online through the supplier and it is delivered to school at retail prices)
3. Pre-packs that are ordered through the school but we require at least 20 packs per class which means this needs 90% parents purchasing through this option.

We would also make the stationery list available to you so you could purchase the books yourself. Teachers have selected specific books for their level so that they can meet the needs of their learners which may not be available at all shops. We also have worked hard to make the stationery consistent across the school so that all children get the same books.
