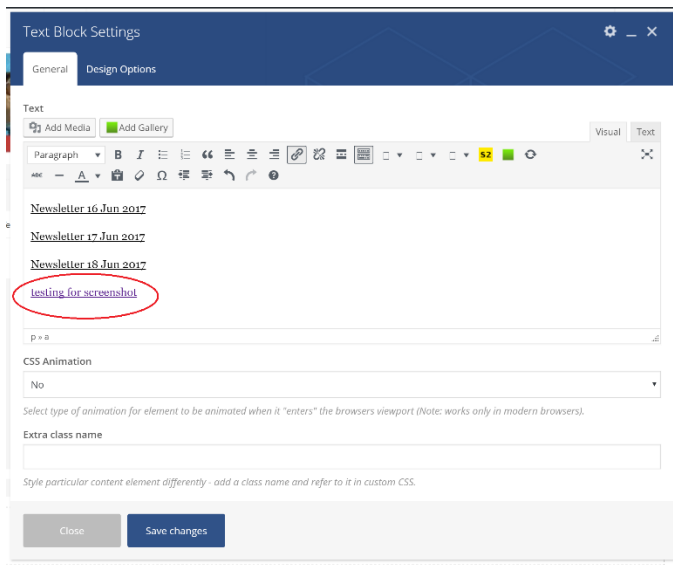
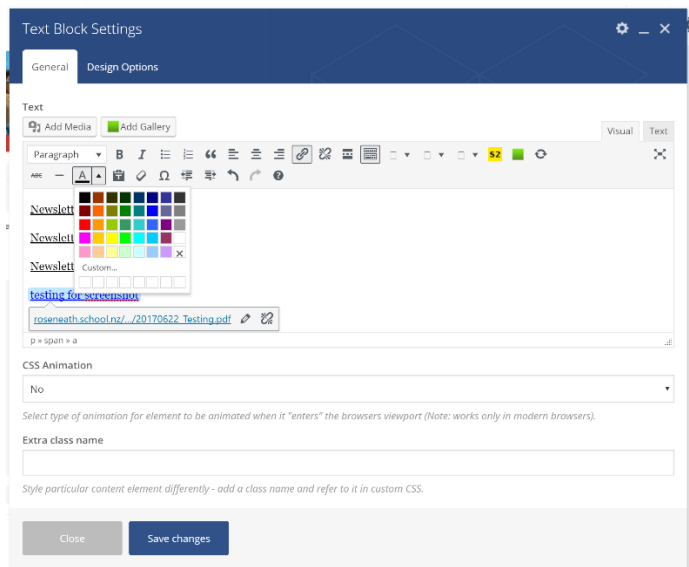


1. Add your media to the library
2. Edit Text Block
3. Add Media (click on media item and insert into page)



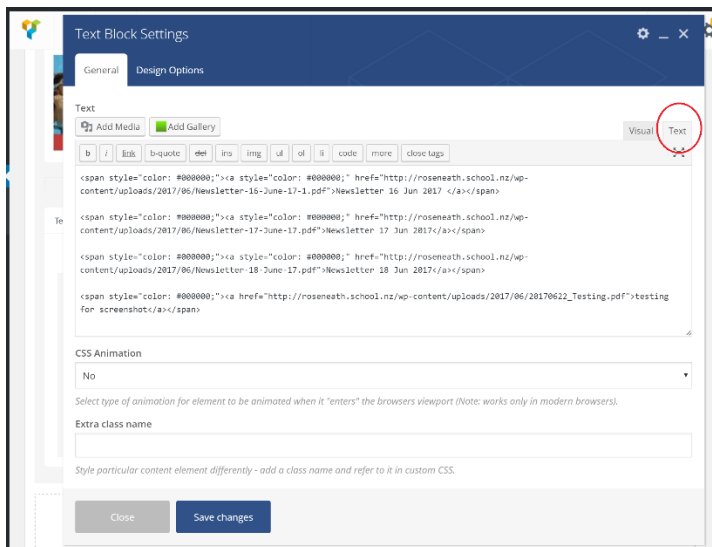
It will default to blue text ..., and the script will reflect no colour, text or link colour

4. Change the **span colour** to Black



5. This changes the span colour, but not the style colour. i.e once you've clicked on the link it will become black. But the initial text will still be blue as per the style colour. The **style colour** is set by the wordpress theme (lincoln), so you will need to override it.,

6. In text block settings click on the Text tab



7. The script for the new entry states:

8. Add in the style override text

```
style="color: #000000;"
```

It will now look like:
